12<sup>th</sup> November 2022



This week we have enjoyed retelling the story of Mr Gumpy's Outing, using the words we learned last week. We drew a story map, used props and drew and labelled the characters from the story. We looked at different types of boats and the children loved sharing photos of themselves (from the emails you sent in!)

In phonics some children learned the graphemes v,w,x and y and some revisited o, c, k and a. We learned more tricky words including has, his, her and and. In maths we looked at and made triangles in different ways. We compared the number of objects in sets by matching them 1:1. For example, we had 3 bears and we had to make sure we had an equal number of bowls, plates, knives, forks and other objects. We reinforced the language of '**more than**', '**fewer than**' and '**an equal number**'. We have also made boats using recycled materials and cut paper and card to make 2D boats.

This week, we have continued to help our friends and have learned to use more resources independently – please practise this at home by encouraging your child to 'have a go' before helping them. You could also challenge your child to:

- Put one foot on each step when walking up and down stairs.
- Let your child cut up their own food with a knife and fork.
- Let them fasten their own coats.

This will help them to be more independent and will help their physical development.

**Next week we are learning about 'whole' and 'parts'. On Friday, could you please send some fruit so we can look at the different parts and so we can make a fruit kebab at snack time! We also need rolls of wallpaper – the children are loving drawing roads and maps!**
