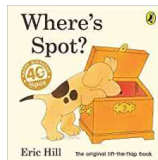
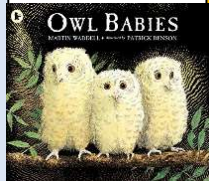
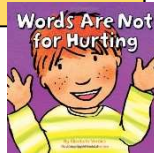


Our value for this half term is Good Manners. We will learn to use the words please and thank you.

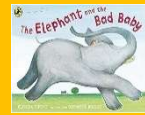
As communicators, we will:

Use pronouns and prepositions.

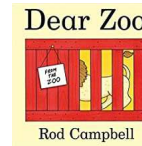
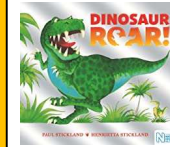


As individuals and friends, we will:

As healthy movers, we will:

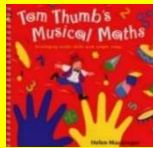
Handle tools in the classroom safely.
