



This week's learning: We have revisited some of our favourite stories and revisited the vocabulary we have already learnt. Owl babies, Goldilocks and the Three Bears and Brown Bear Brown Bear were our chosen texts. Our key vocabulary can be found overleaf. When children listen to the same story multiple times, they pick up new information, dive deeper into the meaning of the book and make connections between the book and other books they've heard. The children enjoyed talking about what they could see and used their gross motor skills to clean the tractor.
