Our topic this half term is 'Ready Steady Grow'. This week we read 'The Tiny Seed' and have been learning about plants and what they need to grow. We planted a seed, wrote instructions on how to do this and have been exploring plants. We also read 'The Yoga Ogre' and watched 'Yellow's Bedtime'. We discussed how to keep ourselves healthy, which is our Value of the term.
