We must start by saying a huge thank you to everyone who came to our Easter craft session on Wednesday. It was great to see so many Mums, Dads, Aunties and Grandparents. We know the children enjoyed it and hope you did too!

This week we have been busy with lots of Easter and Spring activities. We wrote sentences about Spring and drew and painted baby animals and Easter eggs. We practised our cutting skills to make headbands and Easter bunnies and The Easter bunny left us 10 eggs with tricky words written on the back. We had to work with a friend to hunt for the eggs, write the words and then read them to an adult.

In maths this week, we looked at repeating patterns. We learnt about 3D shapes (3 dimensional). We looked at **cubes**, **cuboids**, **spheres**, **cylinders**, **cones**, **pyramids and triangular prisms!** We realised that these shapes are all around us and discussed whether they could **stack**, **roll** or both. we talked about the **faces** being **flat or curved** and looked at the **edges and vertices**! We also combined amounts to pay for our drink and snack this week. We had to add together the prices and work out how to pay for them using 1ps.

Our topic after half term is 'Ready Steady Grow'. We will be learning about plants, life cycles and healthy eating. If you have any seeds, plants or anything else you could donate for our outdoor area, please send them in after the holidays.

We would like to raise some money to improve our outdoor area and will be holding a sponsored event next half term. We will be taking the children on a 'Spring' Walk on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May and we will be sending sponsor forms home after the holiday.
