Tuesday 11th July is 'Shuffle Up Day'. This is for the children moving to school in September. They will visit their new classroom and meet their new teacher. They will need to be collected at 12.15pm from the same entrance. The children will have their lunch at school on this day. The Leavers Show-Friday 21st July AM. This is for the children who are moving to reception/a new school. Children who are staying in nursery for another year need to attend the afternoon session on this day. Please note- there will be NO 30 - hour provision on this day.
