This week our story was “Tadpole’s Promise” by Jeanne Willis. It was about a tadpole and caterpillar who fell in love but the tadpole struggled to keep his promise to ‘not change’. We discussed the themes within the story and talked to the children about the lifecycles of butterflies and tadpoles. Our key words were **promise, fell, tadpole, change, broken, forgive, begged, chance, fluttered** and **wondering**. We also used DK Findout to learn more about frogs and wrote labels and sentences to describe frogs.

We Watched ‘Pink has a new brother’ as part of our PSHE time, and discussed how families can change when new siblings are born or when one family joins with another to create a ‘blended’ family.

In Maths, we have been practising making 10 in different ways. We are getting super quick using our fingers to work out ‘**how many more**’ we needed to make 10. Our stem sentences this week have included:
“9 needs 1 to make 10. 10 is made of 9 and 1.”
