This week we read the story 'Harry saves the Ocean' by N.G.K. The story is about pollution and what we can do to look after our planet. Our key words this week are **rubbish, difference, ocean, dumped, saves, strange, harmful, free, rot and plastics**. Please encourage your child to use these words at home. We wrote descriptive sentences about the characters in the story. We also used 'pointillism' (the use of coloured dots to build a picture) to create fish and made an aquarium of fish in our modelling area.

In maths we practised counting and remembering the 'stopping' number. We looked at the pattern of numbers when counting beyond 20 and discussed how to arrange objects to be able to count them correctly. When counting 20 objects, we put them in rows of 5 to help us remember which ones we had counted!

We watched '**Blue's indoor Voice**' and discussed how we need to use a quiet, calm voice when we are inside. We have been practising a song for our assembly and we completed our multi skills competition!
