We continued our work around 'The Three Little Pigs' this week. We made 'wanted' posters describing the wolf, drew story maps and developed our 'collage' skills to make masks. We also practised drawing and painting people and wolves. We are getting better at retelling the story too!

We revisited google maps to locate our school and places we visit. We used the street view tool (the yellow man) to help us navigate our way around the local area. The children used descriptive language to describe how to get to their house and we talked about different types of houses including detached, semi-detached, terraced and bungalows – together can you spot the different types of houses when you are out and about?
