This week our story is The Three Little Pigs, we drew pictures from the story and wrote descriptive sentences about the pigs using the sentence starters He is, She is, He had, She had. We made collage pictures of the different houses, pig and wolf masks, split pin puppets and drew and painted pictures of pigs and the wolf.



In maths we learnt to use rekenreks (a bit like an abacus) to help us to subitise, count and problem solve to 10.

We heard the story "Rainbow Feels Angry" and discussed how we can control our feelings when we are angry, cross or frustrated.

We used google maps to locate our school and places we visit. We used the street view tool (the yellow man) to help us navigate our way around the local area. We found the Brig, the doctors, the allotments, some shops and the houses where some of the children live. The children loved looking at this and were so excited to find his/her house. Why not have a go at home and see what you can find.
