



What a busy week we have had! Our Class Assembly and our trip to Tropical World! Thank you to everyone who came to watch our assembly – we're sure you will agree that the children did us proud!

Our story this week and next is 'Captain Yellowbelly – The Tale of the Terrible Pirate' by Preston Rutt. It is about a cowardly pirate who has a bad day! It is a funny story (especially when he gets bird poo in his eye!). The children have written super sentences about the pirate and have enjoyed pirate role play both indoors and outside. They have made and painted parrots and pirates and made some wonderful pirate masks – great cutting skills everyone! Our key words from the story are ocean, saves, free, strange, dumped, rubbish, plastics, rot, difference and harmful. We also looked at different types of boats and discussed the material they may be made from including metal, plastic, wood, rubber, glass and cotton. We discussed why boats can't be made from paper and had a go making our own! We then drew our own boats and wrote descriptive sentences.

We have another busy week next week including:
