## New Term

All children in main school receive a free school meal. Children can choose each day what they want to eat. Please see the menu below for next week's options. Sandwich choices each week are ham or cheese.

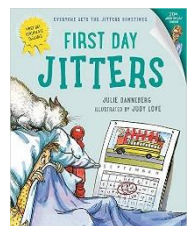
