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After School Clubs

After school clubs will start week beginning 16th September. **On Monday 9th September, a link will be sent out so you can book a club.** Please only choose 1 club in the first instance so that all children have the opportunity to attend. The clubs will be:

Mondays: Miss Tate – Bike/Scooter club (3.15 – 4.00) £2.00 a session (4 weeks)

Children can bring their own bikes/scooters (no electric scooters/bikes allowed) or use a school bike.

Tuesdays: Mrs Woollands – Lego club (3.15 – 4.00) £2.00 a session (4 weeks)

Wednesdays: Hailey Dance School (Dance sessions) (3.15 – 4.00) £3.00 a session (5 weeks)

Reading Books

Over the next few weeks all children will bring home a set of reading books.

1. Once children begin group reading sessions (guided reading) they will receive a Little Wandle book based on their phonetic ability. Children will have read this book in school already so will be familiar with it. **Children will keep this book for a week.** It will be changed after children have accessed a new group session. **If this book is not returned to school a £5.00 charge will be made and no new book will be sent home until the fine is paid.**
2. All children will bring home an individual reading book based on their phonetic ability. Children choose their own book based upon interests and can change this book as many times as they like. **For a new book please write 'Finished' or 'New book please' in their reading diary.**
3. Children also have access to a 'Sharing Book'. They can choose this book from the school library, class libraries, the book boxes put outside each morning or from the outside library (located near the gate in the playground).



We are looking for some new reading volunteers to work in school. If you think you can spare an afternoon or two each week, please let Mrs Hendy know.
