New Term

School re-opens for children in main school on Wednesday 4th September 2024. Doors open at 8.40, with **school starting at 8.45**. Staff will be outside to welcome children into school. Tigers access their classrooms at the front of the building, with Leopards, Jaguars and Panthers accessing their classroom around the back of school. School gates close at 8.50am.

Nursery children have a staggered start. Mrs Windsor sent details of start dates and times to families individually in the Summer Term.

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September 2024

This academic year, you will no longer need to purchase a red book bag (unless you want to) as we will provide children with a 'reading bag'. **We ask that all families donate £2 towards a school water bottle this year as unfortunately, bringing one from home did not work. Please send £2.00 in a named envelope.**

Please ensure all items of your child's school uniform are **clearly labelled** with a name and class.

Children need to bring their **PE kit and book bag** into school the very first week. Due to the shortage of space in the cloakrooms, **P.E. kits must be sent in a drawstring bag.**

On P.E. days children should have their hair tied back. All jewellery with the exception of small stud earrings is strongly discouraged in school. If worn these will need to be removed or covered by your child for P.E.

Hoop earrings and make-up, including nail varnish are not allowed at school.

- Drinks other than water (water is provided at lunchtime by school).



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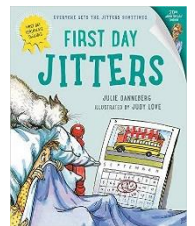


Mrs Baxby
