New Term

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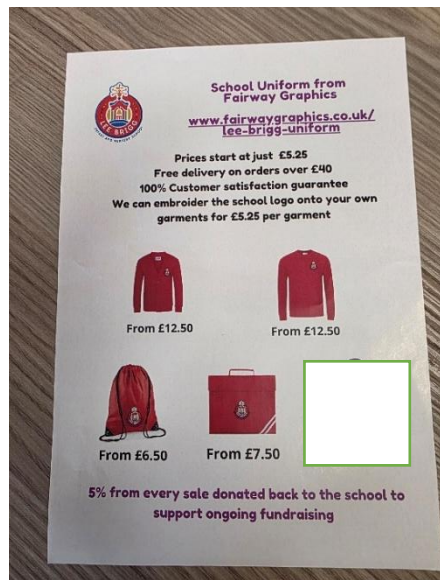

Book Bags

Children in Reception – Year 2 require a red book bag.

You can buy these from fairway graphics, online, in uniform shops or we do have a limited supply in school (red plain bags £2.00 each). We do not mind if they are plain or have the school logo on.

We kindly ask that keyrings are not attached to these as we struggle to fit them in the drawers.

PE Bags

We have very limited space so please send PE kits in a **red draw stringed bag**, either plain or with the school's logo on. Please write your child's name on the bag and in your child's PE kit, including their pumps.

Please do not send rucksacks to school. Unfortunately, due to space restrictions, we will have to send these home.

If you order uniform supplies from Fairway graphics, school receive 5% commission on all purchases.


PE

On P.E. days children should have their hair tied back. All jewellery with the exception of small stud earrings is **strongly discouraged** in school. If worn these will need to be removed or covered by your child for P.E.

Hoop earrings and make-up, including nail varnish are not allowed at school.

- Drinks other than water (water is provided at lunchtime by school).

NEW

This year, we have introduced a 'House' system in school. Children will find out which of the 4 houses they are in on their first day (Houses have been assigned randomly, although siblings are in the same house).



These are:

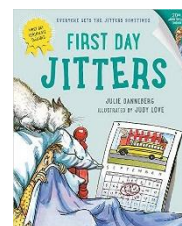
- Oak (Red)
- Ash (Yellow)
- Silver Birch (Green)
- Hawthorne (Blue)

Children will receive 'House Points' (rather than spots, stickers or dojos) for things such as following the school rules, working hard, being kind etc. At the end of each half term, the house with the most points will win a small treat and the house with the most points at the end of the year will win the school trophy. Events such as sports day, children will take part in their house colours, and win points for their team. More information about our relationship and behaviour policy will follow shortly.

First Day Jitters

I'm sure children and grown-ups are feeling very excited but maybe also a little bit anxious about next week. This is normal. Once everyone is back into school routines, anxieties will fade for most children.
